- Rev. 12:11- And they overcame him (the accuser) by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
- Eph. 4:3- Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. John 17:21-
- Psalm 133:1- Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity.
- James 1:19-20- So when, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; for the wrath of man does not work the righteousness of God.
