RECONCILIATION

- **Redemption in Jesus' Blood**
- Rom. 8:33-34- Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.
- Isa. 28:17- I will make justice the measuring line, and righteousness the plummet; the hail will sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters will overflow the hiding place.
- Rev. 12:11- And they overcame him (the accuser) by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
- Micah 6:8. He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you? But to do justly, To love ^[a]mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?

Prayer Points

- Pray for a restoration of courageous and righteous leaders to arise in cities suffering division and riots
- Pray for reconciliation between city leaders, community leaders and police departments.
- Pray for constructive reforms where needed in the justice system
- Pray for restoration of peace and order
- Pray for church leaders to engage in community and social issues and carry the message of healing, forgiveness and justice.

JUSTICE ARISE!

Scriptures to Pray to Affirm God's Promise!

- Rom. 12:19 Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but *rather* give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance *is* Mine, I will repay," says the Lord.
- Amos 5:24. But let justice run down like water, And righteousness like a mighty stream.
- Isaiah 30:18. Therefore the LORD will wait, that He may be gracious to you; And therefore He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you. For the LORD *is* a God of justice; Blessed *are* all those who wait for Him.
- Isa. 33:22- The Lord is our Judge, the Lord is our Lawgiver, the Lord is our King; He will save us;
- 1Kg. 3:9- "Therefore give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours."

- 9 Supreme court judges
- Total 875 judges in federal courts
- State circuit courts
- No partiality in judgment
- Not to judge according to appearance or political agendas; but righteousness
- Wisdom, protection and finances for Christian organizations – ACLJ, Liberty Counsel, Protect Marriage
