RECONCILIATION

- Can two walk together, except they be agreed? Amos 3:3. Pray for unity and oneness
- Pray for peace and against all forms of misunderstanding, contention, and divisiveness.
- Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:3
- Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another. Romans 14:9
- Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: 1 Cor. 4:5
- Pray against lies and false reporting in the media that undermines the authority given Peacemakers by God to do their jobs. Pray that God will expose the darkness and bring every hidden work into His light.
- Let violent and racist crimes be removed from our streets and those who are responsible to serve and protect.

PEACEMAKERS & GUARDIANS ARISE!

Scriptures to Pray to Affirm God's Promise!

- Psalm 91- He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High Will abide in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say to the Lord, "My refuge and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust!"
- Isaiah 43:2- "When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they will not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, nor will the flame burn you.

- Deuteronomy 31:6- Be strong and courageous, do not be afraid or tremble at them, for the Lord your God is the one who goes with you.
- 1 Timothy 2:1-2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in **authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable** life in all godliness and honesty.

Prayer Points

- Pray for peacemakers to be fully prepared physically, emotionally and spiritually to enforce the law. Pray against the spirit of suicide and all forms of domestic violence coming against the peacemaking community. Pray for strong marriages.
- Pray that officers and military would act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with God. Weed out those who do not honor their oath or the badge.
- Many police departments are vastly understaffed. Pray for The Lord to send forth laborers into our communities
- Let Your Goodness come to our 1.4 million personnel on active duty, and 1.2 million personnel on reserve.
- Supernatural Wisdom and guidance to leaders in the military
- Godly Christian chaplains and that they and our armed forces will be able to pray in the name of Jesus and that they will!
- Please protect and heal our troops from PTSD and all other mental, physical, emotional, and spiritual injuries
- Encourage our Police Officers and other Civil Servants and troops and let them be respected again.
